Cycling Cruise - Highlights of Istria Peninsula PLUS

Guided or Self guided E-Bike & Boat Tour

Guide cycling with group | 233 km/145 mi | 7 nights / 8 days



"The heart of Europe" is what the Istrians call their peninsula, inspired by its shape and its position at the crossroads of European arteries, cultures and nations. This is where Central Europe and the world of Mediterranean meet. On this one week tour we explore the most popular part of the Croatian coast.

Fall in love with the Adriatic Sea on this tour!. Relax while being on a romantic motor sailer - your floating home. Get on your bicycle after breakfast, enjoy your lunch break ashore or on board, when meeting our ship in one of the pretty harbours. In the evening our ship awaits us in the next harbour. Enjoy the outstanding cuisine aboard while watching the sunset or stroll around historical harbour towns before going to sleep under the stars... either on deck or in your cabin.

The itinerary of the Istria PLUS tour is the same as the itinerary of the Istria tour, making the PLUS tour on board the Deluxe ship a great alternative should you have difficulties finding availability on this trip. On this tour there is an unlimited e-bike availability as well as some pleasant surprises along the way.

TOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1 (Fri) Omisalj (Embarkation) - Cres

Individual arrival to Omišalj, a charming pirate's nest on the island of Krk. If you decide to arrive by car, we can gladly organize a secure parking space for your car for the week. If you are arriving from Zagreb, we can also arrange a transfer for you to the harbor of Omišalj. Check-in on board is possible from around 2pm. Once we have made ourselves comfortable in our cabins, we enjoy the first crossing to Cres. Our destination is the island capital of the same name, where we spend the night. The Venetian-influenced old town of Cres, with its beautiful alleys and many churches, entices you to take an extensive evening stroll.

DAY 2 (Sat) Cres - Pula (approx. 17 mi./28 km by bike)

In the morning we enjoy our breakfast on board with a pleasant morning cruise to Pula. In the afternoon we explore some picturesque places in and around Pula. Via Galizana we go to Vodnjan and further through the fishing village Fazana before coming back to Pula where we can take part on an inspiring guided city tour before enjoying our evening exploring the town further at our leisure. The night is spent in Pula.

Day 3 (Sun) Pula - Vrsar - Poreč (approx. 26 mi./42 km by bike)

In the morning we enjoy our breakfast on board with another pleasant morning cruise this time to Vrsar. It is in Vrsar that the heartbreaker Casanova is believed to have sought temporary refuge from the husbands of his lovers. From here we cycle along the Linski Canal to Kloštar in the rural hinterland to our destination of Poreč. The town has a lively vibe with its long promenade and shopping streets. A visit to the famous Euphrasius Basilica with its magnificent early Christian mosaics is worth a visit and there is also plenty of time to go for a swim and relax in the afternoon. The night is spent in Poreč.

Day 4 (Mon) Poreč - Novigrad (approx. 41 mi/66 km by bike)

In the morning we follow the "Parenzana", an abandoned railroad line, which leads us to the famous artists' village of Groznan. The picturesque artists' village is a medieval jewel in the Istrian hinterland. It awaits us with romantic alleys, flower-filled squares and diverse galleries that have made their home in old natural stone houses. In the afternoon, we bike through rural Istria via Buje to Novigrad, where we can enjoy the evening and spend the night.

Day 5 (Tue) Rovinj (aprx. 10 mi/16 km)

In the morning, during breakfast, the boat takes us to Rovinj, the starting point of today's cycle tour. You leave the town and follow an old railroad line to the Lim Canal. Near the town, the vast green wilderness of the local park is the perfect backdrop for an optional extension to the cycle tour past picturesque bays where you can stop for a refreshing swim. After a pleasant morning on your bikes and on the beach, you return to the ship and in the afternoon, accompanied by a knowledgeable guide, you have plenty of time to discover the secrets of the town of Rovinj, often called the "Pearl of Istria".

Day 6 (Wed) Rovinj - Fažana - Rabac (aprx. 22 mi/37 km)

Our morning bike ride takes us near the coast, mostly on natural forest paths to Fažana, with its quaint little harbor and promenade lined with colorful houses. We board the boat and enjoy a cruise along the coast to Rabac. Here, located on a picturesque bay on the east coast of Istria, we can enjoy gorgeous white pebble beaches, crystal clear waters and a beautiful harbor. Not to be missed is an evening cocktail in a local bar.

Day 7 (Thu) Rabac - Njivice - Omišalj (aprx. 27 mi/44 km)

In the early morning, we cross to the island of Krk, where a final cycling stage awaits us. The route will lead us from Njivice to Omišalj. The largest island in Croatia and home of the delicious Zlahtina white wine impresses with its diverse landscapes. Don't miss the opportunity to cover yourself in the mineral rich mud in the bay of Soline - it will not only leave you looking ten years younger, but also makes for a wonderful holiday memory! Back in the harbor of Omišalj, our boat awaits us with a delicious last evening meal on board which can be spent in great cheer in the company of the fellow travelers, crew and guides.

Day 8 (Fri) Omisalj (Disembarkation)

After breakfast disembarkation until 9 am and individual trip home or extended stay in Croatia.

Itinerary changes

We reserve the right to make changes to the planned itinerary due to changing wind and weather conditions as well as organizational requirements.

Level 3/5

Cycling tours through hilly terrain with longer ascents of up to approximately 250 meters. All tours, including the elevation gains, can be mastered more easily with electronic assistance. Suitable for cyclists who ride regularly and can confidently navigate varying surface conditions.

Distance: 16 – 66 km per day

Total elevation: 200 – 600m of elevation per day

Road conditions: 70% paved roads, 30% on unpaved roads and forest paths.

Infrastructure: There are only a few designated bike paths in Istria, so the bike tours take place on public roads, preferably on quiet side streets.

Relevant for all levels:

Safe cycling skills and familiarity with road traffic are prerequisites for taking part in our tours. Anyone renting an e-bike should already have experience and be confident in handling e-bikes, as these bikes are significantly heavier and faster than conventional bikes.

Guided group pace:

On our e-bike tour programs, the riding pace is determined by the cyclists on e-bikes. Guests who are taking part on these tours on a gravel bike should have the necessary physical condition to keep up with this pace. We thank you for your understanding.

Individual cycling:

This tour is primarily a guided group tour. Upon consultation with your tour guides, the possibility to cycle on your own along recommended, suitable roads may present itself. You are free to set aside a half or full day to swim or spend on board the boat, instead of taking a planned bike tour.

WHAT THE TOUR PRICE INCLUDES

Services included:

- 8 day trip on a motorized yacht with crew
- 7 nights in a twin bed cabin with shower/toilet

Not included

Bike hire is not included in the tour price

€205 Road bike or gravel bike with water bottle cage, lock

€260 Electric - bike with water bottle cage, lock and a small pannier bag

- Basic drink-package (bottled water, tea and filter coffee), visitor's tax and local charges 80 Euro for adults / 40 Euro for children up to age of 16 (to be paid to the captain)

THE BOAT

Deluxe Ship ANDELA LORA (all cabins with shower/toilet)

At 40 x 8.5 m the Andela Lora is an extraordinary, elegant steel ship, built in 2012. With its impressive length it is one of the largest ships in our Croatian fleet. The 17 spacious guest cabins are air-conditioned and include a shower and WC. The Andela Lora also offers a cozy salon on the top deck and numerous comfortable spaces on deck to relax. At the stern of the ship, a swimming platform provides effortless access to the sea.



Catering

The on-board chef is a member of the crew and prepares the breakfast and one or two warm meals a day. The catering consists of 2x full board and 5x half board. Catering starts with the dinner on the arrival day and ends with breakfast on the departure day.



WHAT TO BRING

Specialised cycle clothing may be handy but not strictly necessary. What you do need (among other things) is the following:

- shorts/ long trousers/ track suit/ leggings
- shirts/ sweater/ rain clothing
- good shoes
- sunglasses/ cap/ swimming costume
- extra towel for swimming
- soap/ insect repellent
- helmet (Rental helmets are available on board in limited number, reservation requested)

GROUP, GUIDE AND BACK-UP SERVICE

There is no support vehicle available on this tour, but there is no time pressure to finish the stages. You also have the option to stay on the boat if you wish.

You are free to set aside a half or full day swim or spend on board the boat, instead of taking a planned bike tour. We will traverse mostly asphalted roads, which are rarely travelled on outside the holiday seasons. Each day you can either decide to bike alone, using the information and maps provided, or join the tour guides and other participants.

Electric bikes are an additional €260.00



Clients who wish to be supported by a tail-wind and seek to hire an e-bike will receive a high-quality cycle, powered mainly by a Bosch motor capable of covering long distances, and characterized by their light weight and great components. Alternative drive systems may also be used. Standard components of our e-bikes in varying frame sizes include, 28 inch hollow chamber rims with puncture-proof touring tires, high-quality derailleur gears and break systems, a carrier and a sturdy bike stand, touring saddle as well as mudguards and a pannier rack. With our e-bikes you will conquer the hills with a smile, they are a true declaration of independence for all who wish to cycle and seek the support of a little push. Unfortunately there is no possibility to reserve one particular bike-brand in advance.

Road bikes or gravel bikes are €205

Helmet use is mandatory on all bike tours in Croatia. You are strongly encouraged to bring your own (well fitted) helmet. Rental Helmets are available on board in limited number (reservation requested).

The Bike tours require basic level of fitness from participants, which they should have acquired from steady cycling. The day tours from 20 - 60km will take you through hilly and mountainous terrain and may be completed without any time constraints. Participants will also need to master long and steep climbs during which they are, however, also able to push their bikes.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Bringing Children:

We believe that only children in a good physical condition and of a minimum age of 10 and previous bicycle tour experience are able to master the bike-tours on their own strength. Please note that the minimum height for a rental e-bike is 1,50 m (4.9 ft.)

Catering:

The on-board chef is a member of the crew and prepares the breakfast and one or two warm meals a day. The catering consists of 2x full board and 5x half board. Catering starts with the dinner on the arrival day and ends with breakfast on the departure day.

Language

Due to our international audience the tour is conducted bilingually, in English and German.
